Roy served as President of the Carisbrooke Community Association for eight years. He worked hard to protect our community as well as make it the well cared for and close knit neighborhood it is. Roy enjoyed entertaining the children of the neighborhood as many different characters throughout the Holidays. He was the Easter Bunny, Mad Scientist, Uncle Sam, Santa Claus and others over his years living in Carisbrooke.

Roy was also a passionate educator. He believed in transforming minds to love the sciences and art. He strove to express these loves in his daily life. He was an inspirational teacher who touched many lives during his 40+ years as a Professor at ODU. Roy was very pleased when TLC started the scholarship for the children of our neighborhood.

It was because of Roy's love of education and children that TLC voted to change the name of our Scholarship to honor him and his contributions to the community.
